CLASS descriptions

ACRYLIC

Study composition, tone, and how to use this versatile water-based medium from creating texture to creating watercolor-like effects.

AUTOMOTIVE PREVENTIVE MAINTENANCE

This course presents a better understanding of automotive preventative maintenance in areas such as visual inspections, hands-on lubrication, tune-up, emission controls, brakes, tires, electrical, front-end, air conditioning, exhaust system, cooling system, fluid levels, belts, hoses, primary wiring and last but not least, state safety requirements.

BEGINNER BEADING

Learn the basics of beading which includes design layout, stringing and crimping. Supplies are included with this class.

BEGINNER OIL PAINTING

You will learn the principles of design, color theory, and about oil paint properties in this two session class. You will also learn to create a monochromatic study and color still-life with this revered art form.

BEGINNER POLYMER CLAY

Beginners will learn the properties and characteristics of polymer clay and basic color theory using instructor designs or creating your own designs. Students will create one or more of the following: ornaments, figurines, jewelry.

CERAMICS

Seniors/Youth/Open Workshop
These classes will enable you to learn the basics of ceramics and various techniques. The instructor will guide you in making your ceramic piece and supply selections. Youth ceramics students will have the opportunity to choose their own ceramic piece to glaze.

CERAMICS w/POURING LESSONS

This class covers safety, tools, proper use of molds, pouring of ceramic molds, pulling of greenware from mold, attachments, cleaning of greenware, glazing, firing, gold and

decal firing. At the end of this class you will be certified to do your own mold pouring for your own projects at the Arts & Crafts Center.

COLLAGE

Learn how to turn photographs and found objects into a work of art with this new class.

CROCHET

Learn thread selection, how to read patterns and crocheting techniques.

FRAMING I

You will have the opportunity to frame your own 11 x 14 (or smaller) photo. Learn how to cut matting, sub-straight, glass and wood molding. Upon completion of this class you will receive a qualification card enabling you to use the self-help shop for future framing projects.

GIUITAR

Learn how to play the guitar! Lessons are catered to your skill level in this per-hour class.

HANDBUILT POTTERY

Express yourself in this unique art form and create a one-of-a-kind piece formed by hand. Learn slab rolling, coil making, impression work, pinching methods, firing, and glazing in this four-session class for ages 15 to adult.

HOME IMPROVEMENT

These hands-on home improvement classes are geared especially towards women and taught by women using tools specifically designed for women.

KNITTING

Learn to read patterns, use markers and knit with various threads. Suggested projects include a poncho, purse, scarf, hat or afghan.

POTTERY WHEEL

An instructor will guide you in learning the skill of using a pottery wheel to form bowls, cups, and vases. You will also learn to make and attach handles. To finish your creation, the instructor will also teach you how to use underglazes and or/glazes to finish your pottery.

PRINTMAKING MONOTYPE & RELIEF

Learn to create your own prints by applying monotype designs on plexiglass. Also learn how to apply a design to styrofoam which will be transferred to paper.

SEWING

This class, open to anyone ages 10 and up, teaches sewing techniques which include selection of material, cutting fabric, pattern layout and machine sewing.

WATERCOLOR

This class covers composition, line, tone, color mixing and wet-into-wet technique, sponging out, and brush strokes.

WOODWORKING I

In this class, you will learn the basics of woodworking with an emphasis on safety and proper use of hand tools and stationary machines. This class qualifies you to use many of the tools and machinery in the wood shop. The \$30 fee includes woodshop certification and a month's use of the facility.
