WHAT IS THE ALTERNATE ESCAPES WIRELESS NETWORK?

WI-FI COMPUTER NETWORKING TECHNOLOGY, ALLOWS COMPUTERS AND PERSONAL DIGITAL ASSISTANTS (PDAs) TO SEND AND RECEIVE INTERNET DATA VIA A WIRELESS NETWORK. THIS LOCATION OFFERS YOU A SECURE, RELIABLE AND FAST WAY TO ACCESS THE INTERNET. THE REVENUE GENERATED FROM THIS SERVICE IS USED TO FUND MWR ACTIVITIES WORLDWIDE.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED

You need a laptop, notebook computer or a PDA equipped with a standard internet browser and a Wi-Fi compliant wireless Ethernet card. In most cases, the card will be installed in the PCMCIA slot on the side of the computer and will be loaded with the appropriate software.

Note: Some newer laptops have built-in Wi-Fi capability, in which the operating system alerts the user of an available Wi-Fi network when the browser is open.

CONNECTING WITH A PREFERRED CONNECTION

1. Click Start and Open Control Panel.
2. Click Network and Internet.
3. Connections—Network connections.
4. Right click Wireless Network Connection and select Properties.
5. Click Wireless Networks Tab; under Preferred Networks, click Add.
6. Enter network Name (SSID): Wireless Escape (case sensitive). Make sure Data Encryption, Network Authentication and Computer to Computer. Ad Hoc

Network boxes are all unchecked.

7. Click OK to save settings. Move selected network to the top of the list.
8. Select and remove any unrecognized Preferred Networks entries you have not set up.
9. Click Advanced and check Access point networks only and uncheck "Automatically connect to non-preferred networks".
10. Click Close, then Click OK and close Network connections.
11. You do not need to restart your computer.
12. Open your browser and you will be directed to the alternate Escape portal where you can sign up for a service plan or you can login as an existing user.
13. During the sign up process you will pick a service plan and then have to provide credit or debit card information, name, address, phone number and e-mail address. You will also be required to choose a user name and password. Additionally you will need to select a security question and answer.
14. You are now set to surf the internet.
