MEMORANDUM FOR ALL DINING FACILITY PATRONS

SUBJECT: Dress Standards for Military Dining Facilities

1. To ensure a pleasant dining experience for all patrons and adherence to policy and procedures, the following dress and appearance standards will apply to all personnel who utilize Lackland's dining facilities:

a. For Airmen and other Military members: Military dress must be IAW AFI 36-2903, Air Force Dress and Appearance standards or applicable directives for uniform wear for Army, Navy, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard personnel.

b. The following are strictly prohibited:

(1) Civilian clothing combined with military clothing that has distinctive military items/logos such as grade insignia, cap devices, or buttons with the Air Force Coat of Arms.

(2) Clothing items bearing symbols or statements that are profane, lewd, offensive, or obscene.

(3) Bare chest, tank tops, halter tops, sleeveless shirts and blouses, cut-off pants or shirts that expose private areas of the body or undergarments.

(4) Bare feet or shower shoes.

(5) Airmen in soiled fitness clothing after workout or exercising—the expectation is that you will prepare “take out” and not remain in the dining facility.

(6) Unauthorized body piercings and obscene tattoos.

(7) Only approved religious head coverings and food service inspector/evaluator headgear are allowed for wear inside the dining facility. No other headgear is authorized.
