Rule of the Month

24-2 Immovable Obstructions

a. Interference

Interference by an immovable obstruction occurs when a ball lies in or on the obstruction, or when the obstruction interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing. If the player's ball lies on the putting green, interference also occurs if an immovable obstruction on the putting green intervenes on his line of putt. Otherwise, intervention on the line of play is not, of itself, interference under this Rule.

How does this affect us here at Gateway Hills? You might have notice some green irrigation controller boxes on the course. These are immovable obstructions, you are entitled to stance and swing relief within one club length, no closer to the hole. However, you are not entitled to line of flight.

The Importance of Clubfitting

Do you look your best in a suit that you buy off of the rack or one that is custom tailored to your exact body type? Your golf clubs are no different. Even if you think that your swing is perfect your body type and swing is unique to only you. Clubs that are to flat (toe down) for your swing will result in shots hit out to the right. Conversely, clubs that are to upright (toe up) will produce a shot primarily to the left of the target. Whether your looking to buy new clubs or still in love with your good old reliable set.
