Location:

Will be held at Northwest Vista College in San Antonio, Texas. The College is located off of Hwy 151 near Sea World. (3535 N. Ellison Dr, San Antonio, Texas 78251)

Transportation:

Shuttle service provided to and from Lackland. Participants must arrive at the Youth Center (bldg 8420) no later than 0800.

Dates:

Applications due by May 3, 2010. Selected individuals will be notified by May 10, 2010. The Camp will be held June 14-18, 2010.

Cost:

Eligible Applicants:

The applicant must meet the following requirements:

- Contact the Lackland Youth Programs Teen Coordinator to set up an interview.
- After the interview process has been completed, Youth Programs staff should forward complete, qualified applications to the Youth Director for consideration.
- All completed applications must be received by May 3, 2010.
